In recognition of their valuable services for exemplary acts in the conduct of search and rescue operation resulting in saving of life at sea during the tropical storm "AGATON". Imbued with dedication and competence in the performance of their mandates, these men and women responded to the call of duty when said storm lashed in the different municipalities in the Province of Capiz last 12-14 April 2022.

On the said date during the lashed of Agaton, the above-mentioned Auxiliarist together with CGS Capiz, All Sub-stations, OPCON Units, Roxas CDRRMO, BFP, Philippine Red Cross Emergency Response Unit (PRC-ERU), and Mambusao MDRRMO maneuvered their floating assets to evacuate more than eight hundred (800) civilian from different municipalities to its assigned evacuation center. Also, one (1) rescued drowning incident happened in Brgy. Capuyan, Sigma, Capiz because of the high flood due to strong rainfall and was found on 14 April 2022.

By this significant achievement, subject member of PCGA 604th CGAS earned distinct credit and appreciation worthy of simulation not only for themselves and the command but also for the whole Philippine Coast Guard as well, which is in keeping the optimum and finest tradition of the Coast Guard Service.
