“BINALIW! Trash Talk: Pride of Place and Waste Management,” organized by Palm Grass The Cebu Heritage Hotel, is part of its monthly discussions that connect cultural identity with current environmental issues. Held on February 21, 2026, from 3:00–5:00 PM as a hybrid event (in-person and livestream), the forum focuses on the relationship between community pride and waste management, particularly in relation to the Binaliw landfill situation. The discussion features expert insights from our very own CGADCV, AUX LCDR IAN DOMINIC TABAÑAG PCGA specializing on solid waste management systems, Atty. Aliko Garganera on Cebu’s waste management challenges and opportunities, and climate justice advocate Mr. Lito Vasquez on environmental and sustainability impacts, with the presence of Cebu City Vice Mayor Hon. Tomas Osmeña. The program also includes testimonies from

Binaliw resident Mr. Bienvinido Ranido, whose family was affected by a landfill landslide, and Barangay Councilor Hon. Daisy Tuftud Ople Ybañez, providing community perspectives. Overall, the event aims to foster balanced dialogue between experts and stakeholders to help protect Cebu's environment while preserving its cultural heritage.
