Establishing collaborative programs with CTU Moalboal on MARSAP (Maritime Safety), MAREP (Marine Environmental Protection), MARSAR (Maritime Search and Rescue), and MCOMREL (Maritime Community Relations) in support of the Adopt-a-Coastal-Barangay Project at Bangag Fish Sanctuary, Brgy. Saavedra, Moalboal.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS:**

At 0900H on March 4, 2026 The 202nd PCGA Squadron held a collaborative meeting with the Philippine Coast Guard Substation Moalboal, Cebu Technological University (CTU) – Moalboal Campus, officials from the College of Engineering and College of Fisheries to discuss the proposed Academe Partnership for the establishment of a PCGA CCAD Outpost in Brgy. Saavedra, Moalboal, as well as the Adopt-a-Barangay Project.

During the meeting, the 2026 program flow was discussed and valuable inputs were received from all participating parties. The initiative aims to develop joint programs in MARSAP (Maritime Safety), MAREP (Marine Environmental Protection), MARSAR (Maritime Search and Rescue), and MCOMREL (Maritime Community Relations), enabling CTU Moalboal students and faculty to collaborate with the PCGA in training, research, and community-based coastal initiatives. Everyone was to an agreement and would further proceed with initial programs to be implemented and long term programs for planning and possible funding options from different agencies as well.

These efforts will further support the Adopt-a-Coastal-Barangay Project at Bangag Fish Sanctuary, Brgy. Saavedra, promoting sustainable coastal management, environmental stewardship, and stronger community engagement in Moalboal.

The meeting concluded at 1200H.
