I. **TIME COVERED:** 0600H – 1200H, 19 March 2026

II. **VENUE:** Back of the SRP Welcome Hill Tower, Cebu City

III. **MISSION**

To support coastal environmental protection and community welfare through the conduct of cleanup operations and hygiene initiatives, in alignment with the Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary's functions on Marine Environmental Protection (MAREP) and Marine Community Relations (MARCOMREL), by mobilizing auxiliary personnel to reduce marine pollution, promote environmental awareness, and strengthen partnerships with local government units, educational institutions, and coastal communities.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS**

On 19 March 2026, members of the 202nd, 217th, and 219th Auxiliary Squadrons actively participated in and supported the Cebu City

Government, in partnership with PAREF Springdale School, during a Cleanup Drive and Hygiene Kit Giving Activity conducted at the back of the SRP Welcome Hill Tower, Cebu City.

The cleanup drive, participated by all three said squadrons (202nd, 217th, and 219th CGAS), demonstrated strong inter-squadron collaboration, with all participating units contributing to the collection and segregation of waste materials within the designated coastal area. The event was also graced by Honorable Mayor Nestor Archival Sr who was instrumental in the success of the activity. The members were able to collect a total of 4,731 items weighing approximately 1,522.01kg of trashes from a distance of 3.57 kilometers. The data below presents a ranked list of the items collected during the cleanup:

Rank	Item	Total (pcs)	Percent
1	Plastic/foam pieces	610	12.89%
2	Food wrappers (candy, chips, etc.)	511	10.80%
3	Other bags (plastic)	492	10.40%
4	Strapping bands	388	8.20%
5	Grocery bags (plastic)	317	6.70%
6	Straws/stirrers (plastic)	249	5.26%
7	Beverage bottles (plastic)	240	5.07%
8	Other waste (metal, paper, etc.)	198	4.19%
9	Utensils (plastic)	163	3.45%
10	Other plastic bottles (oil, bleach, etc.)	150	3.17%

The data indicates that plastic-related waste remains the dominant pollutant in the area, particularly plastic/foam fragments, food packaging, and various forms of plastic bags. The presence of single-use plastics such as straws, beverage bottles, and utensils further highlights ongoing environmental concerns linked to improper waste disposal and consumption patterns. These findings reinforce the need for continuous coastal cleanup efforts, stricter waste management practices, and sustained community education on environmental stewardship.

Subsequently, members of the 202nd and 219th Auxiliary Squadrons conducted the Hygiene Kit Giving Activity to the Badjao Community in Mambaling, Cebu City. This initiative aimed to promote personal hygiene and community well-being by distributing essential hygiene kits to beneficiaries in the area, complementing the environmental objectives of the cleanup drive.
