I. **TIME COVERED:** 1300H-1500H, March 29, 2026

II. **VENUE:** Plaza Poblacion, Moalboal

III. **MISSION:**

One of the main objectives of the PCGA is to promote safety of life and property at sea, safeguard marine environment and resources, enforce all applicable laws within Philippine waters, and conduct maritime security operations and other activities in support of national development. To support its mandate, the 202.3 CGAS members participated in this BFP Fire Olympics held in Moalboal Cebu.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS:**
