I. **TIME COVERED:** 1300H-1700H, March 23, 2026 – April 1, 2026

II. **VENUE:** Social Hall, LGU Moalboal Cebu & Basdaku Beach

III. **MISSION:**

To enhance the operational readiness and competency of 202.3 CGAS members, local lifeguards, coastal responders, and partner stakeholders in Moalboal by delivering standardized, PCG-aligned training in water safety, rescue operations, and emergency response. This initiative supports the Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary's mandate to promote the safety of life and property at sea, strengthen marine environmental protection, and reinforce community-based maritime security and preparedness in key coastal tourism areas.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS:**

The Municipality of Moalboal, through the Moalboal Tourism Office headed by Tourism Officer Liz Arden Aquino in partnership with the SOG Division of the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and the PCGA 202<sup>nd</sup> CGAS led by AUX CAPT AUDRIE KYLE HOLAYSAN PCGA concluded a comprehensive Lifeguard Training held on March 23–April 1, 2026 at the Moalboal Social Hall. The activity aimed to equip local lifeguards and responders with essential competencies in water safety and emergency response. The ten-day course combined classroom lectures and hands-on pool exercises covering emergency care principles, basic life support, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), operation of the automated external defibrillator (AED), rescue breathing, and foreign body airway obstruction management. Participants were required to pass skills

demonstrations and a written post-test to ensure readiness for real-world incidents, in accordance with recognized standards for lifeguard services and water safety training.

The activity was made possible through the coordinated planning, financial support, and direction of 202.3 Division Direction AUX LCDR IAN DOMINIC TABAÑAG PCGA, alongside Deputy DAS 202nd AUX CDR NIGEL PSALM YAP PCGA, and Site Coordinators AUX LCDR RONALD GERALDEZ PCGA and AUX Jocelle Cagatan PCGA. Tourism Officer Liz Arden Aquino expressed her gratitude to the 202<sup>nd</sup> CGAS likewise PCG-SOG instructors for sharing their expertise and underscored the importance of having well-trained lifeguards in a prime tourist destination like Moalboal, known for its beaches and marine attractions. She emphasized that the training supports the local government's continuing efforts to ensure the safety of both residents and visitors enjoying the town's coastal areas. A total of 40 participants from various barangays, resorts, the LGU Moalboal, and members of the 202.3 CGAS took part in the training program. Even Concluded at April 1, 2026 at 1500H closing with recognition and certificate distribution.
