The team rendered medical consultations using a state-of-the-art rapid whole-body evaluation device capable of delivering a comprehensive health assessment in

approximately five minutes per patient. Medicines, drinking water, and other essential aid were likewise distributed, while compassionate care was extended through the collaborative efforts of local responders and Singaporean medical volunteers. A total of 305 individuals received medical treatment and assistance during the mission.

The activity was successfully concluded at 1700H, with volunteers billeted overnight in public school facilities graciously provided by the Local Government Unit of Bantayan.
