- I. **TIME COVERED:** 0900H-1100H, June 11, 2026
- II. **VENUE:** Basdiot, Moalboal
- III. **MISSION:**

In line with the mandates of the Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary (PCGA) on Maritime Search and Rescue (SAR), Maritime Safety, and Public Service, the mission aims to support the safety and security of lives by providing immediate assistance and emergency response whenever needed. While primarily focused on maritime operations, the PCGA remains committed to extending first aid, rescue, and humanitarian assistance on land during public events and emergencies. PCGA personnel stand ready to assist the public by ensuring a safe environment, promoting preparedness, and responding promptly to any incidents that may arise in the spirit of volunteerism, patriotism, and service to the nation.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS:**

At approximately 0930H, personnel from 202.3 Coast Guard Auxiliary Squadron (CGAS) AUX3 RELIER OROYAN PCGA & AUX2 RICHARD A FLORES PCGA, responded to an incident involving two Korean nationals which one of the two were found unconscious while the other was found injured, at a resort in Moalboal. Initial information revealed that the victims, both male, were riding a motorcycle when they lost control, causing the vehicle to skid and collide with a parked SUV. Upon discovering the victims,

AUX3 OROYAN PCGA immediately notified fellow 202.3 CGAS members for assistance while AUX2 RICHARD A FLORES PCGA monitored the victims. Drawing from their Basic Life Support training, responding members promptly rendered aid and secured the scene. AUX CDR NIGEL PSALM YAP PCGA & AUX LCDR RONALD GERALDEZ PCGA immediately coordinated with the Badian District Hospital and requested ambulance assistance. Simultaneously, AUX1 MA CHARY TUBALADO PCGA & AUX1 CAREN M PATOC PCGA attended to the victims, providing reassurance and emotional support while ensuring they remained calm and stable to prevent further complications. Administrative and coordination support was provided by AUX CDR ROSE PATINO PCGA. Basic first aid measures were administered, including wound assessment and dressing for one of the injured Korean nationals. The second victim was advised to remain immobile on the ground to minimize the risk of aggravating any possible spinal or internal injuries while awaiting professional medical assistance. At approximately 0950H, the Badian District Hospital ambulance arrived on scene with medical personnel, who conducted further assessment and safely transported both victims to Badian District Hospital for comprehensive medical evaluation and treatment. Following medical examination and observation, both Korean nationals were cleared by attending physicians and discharged from Badian District Hospital at approximately 1100H. No life-threatening injuries were reported, and both individuals were declared fit to continue their travel activities.

V. **RECOMMENDATIONS:**
