I. **TIME COVERED:** 0630H – 0900H, June 12, 2026

II. **VENUE:** Plaza Independencia, Cebu

III. **MISSION**

To support the observance of the 128th Philippine Independence Day through active participation in civic-military activities, demonstrating patriotism, discipline, and volunteer service in partnership with government agencies and the local community, while reaffirming our commitment to nation-building, public service, and the protection of the Filipino people and maritime domain.

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS**

At 0600H, 202<sup>nd</sup> CGAS members as well as other uniformed agencies assembled at Plaza Sugbo in preparation for the Civic-Military Parade, which officially commenced at 0630H and proceeded toward Plaza Independencia. At 0700H, the celebration continued with a Eucharistic Celebration, offering prayers of thanksgiving for the

nation's freedom and blessings. At 0800H, a Flag-Raising Ceremony and Wreath-Laying Ceremony were conducted at Plaza Independencia, with the Joint Task Group–Cebu, 31st Infantry Division, Philippine Army serving as the military host. The ceremony was graced by the presence of Hon. Nestor D. Archival, Mayor of Cebu City and Guest of Honor, together with Hon. Tomas R. Osmeña, Vice Mayor and CHAC Chairman. Following the ceremonial rites, the formal program commenced with welcome remarks from Vice Mayor Osmeña, followed by a message from Mayor Archival highlighting the significance of the 128th Philippine Independence Day celebration. The event concluded with the participation of government agencies, uniformed services, civic organizations, and members of the public in a united expression of patriotism, national pride, and commitment to nation-building. Event ended at 0900H
